The Chairman welcomed everybody to the Annual Parish Meeting.

1. **THE MINUTES** of the meeting of 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2014, which had been circulated, were confirmed and signed by the Chairman.

2. **CHAIRMAN'S REPORT OF THE PARISH COUNCIL.**

The Chairman's report, which had been circulated in the spring edition of the Council's newsletter, was accepted. Mr B Sabberton-Coe stated that any questions regarding his report would be taken under public discussion.

3. **ACCOUNTS OF THE YEAR ENDING 31.03.2015.**

The un-audited accounts were accepted. She assured all those present that the accounts were readily available for inspection in her office and under the Freedom of Information Act any resident was allowed to see the accounts.

4. **REPORTS OF REPRESENTATIVES AND ORGANISATIONS.**

Written reports were received from Catton Park Trust Ltd, Old Catton Society and Norfolk County Councillor Mrs J Leggett (copies of which are attached).

District Councillor Mr Ken Leggett thanked the Council for allowing him to speak at Council Meeting's and for everyone's support at the recent elections.

District Councillor Mrs Karen Vincent introduced herself and thanked everyone for their support so far.

The Horticultural Society gave a verbal report.

It was noted that £118,000 has been raised for MacMillan Cancer Support with some money raised at the annual ring road walk.

Mrs Ann Chandler gave an update on the Allotments in Spixworth Road. There are 100 allotment holders with approximately 20 on the waiting list. Allotments are charged at £15.00 a year.

PC Keith Lambert gave an update on crime for the Parish. He stated that although there were some issues things were quite quiet on the whole. The Clerk mentioned the anti-social behaviour taking place at Lavaré Park. Everyone was assured that this was under control and will be dealt with immediately. PC Lambert and PCSO McCue were thanked for all their

efforts with regard to crime and anti-social behaviour within the Parish.

**5. PUBLIC DISCUSSION.**

A resident stated that there are weeds coming through the footpath in The Warren that was laid about a year ago. It is also cracking. The Clerk to inform Highways.
